The Australian Industrial Relations Commission Centennial Prize

NOTICE TO ALL 2010 RESEARCH STUDENTS

To commemorate 100 years of federal conciliation and arbitration, members of the AIRC established a trust to fund the AIRC Centennial Prize, an annual award offered according to the following terms:

1. The prize is valued at \$360 in 2010 (Net Annual Income of the Fund).
2. The prize is open to research students, both undergraduate and postgraduate, who have undertaken study at the Faculty of Arts or the Faculty of Business & Economics, at the University of Melbourne.
3. The research work submitted for consideration must be in the area of Industrial Relations or Labour History.
4. The prize shall be awarded by the Faculty of Arts and the Faculty of Business & Economics, upon recommendation of the Deans (or nominees), after consultation with an Australian Industrial Relations Commission (AIRC) representative.
5. Selection of the best research work will be based on the quality of the essay or thesis and relevance of the research to the AIRC and the community.
6. To be eligible the thesis or essay must have been submitted in 2010, or be ready for submission by the application deadline. Incomplete work will not be considered.

Applications are invited from students who meet the above criteria.
